#### **Impact**

The AAS journals are among the topranked journals in astronomy.

Articles published in the AAS journals account for 28% of total citations in astronomy and astrophysics each year. You'll reach beyond academia too – in the first six months of 2018, research from the AAS journals created 3,139 news stories in more than 50 countries.

#### **Visibility**

Once published, your research is immediately available globally in thousands of libraries. On average, papers published with us receive more than 90 downloads. Your article may be promoted on social media, through our e-mail alerts, or even featured on AAS Nova.

Twelve months after publication, the AAS will make your article freely accessible worldwide. Additionally, you are welcome to post your article in institutional repositories, personal websites, or on arXiv.


#### **Fast Publication**

Articles submitted to RNAAS are published online within three business days of acceptance, thanks to the light-touch moderation process. In addition, ApJL publishes papers within 13 days from acceptance, and ApJ and AJ within 33 days.
